CHC43315 *Certificate IV in Mental Health*

The past decade has seen a vast increase in the number of people needed for employment in the community and mental health services. One in three Australians will experience mental health challenges at some point in their lives, and this qualification will equip you with the knowledge and understanding to help those affected by mental health issues.

This Certificate IV equips you with specialised skills that will enable you to provide professional support and guidance to diverse groups and individuals.

Giving back to your community can be very rewarding.

This course reflects the role of workers who provide self-directed recovery orientated support for people affected by mental illness and psychiatric disability. The course will involve implementing community based programs and activities focusing on mental health, mental illness and psychiatric disability.

What you will learn

You will learn the principles of recovery-oriented practice, communication techniques to build and maintain relationships, and you will learn how to support people with co-existing mental health and alcohol

and other drug issues. There will be advice on skills and techniques which you can implement to promote recovery and well-being. To achieve this qualification, you will need to complete 120 hours of work placement experience which will be at one of our fully functional rehabilitation centres.



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Flexible and supportive learning:

Learning is over a 9 month period. Your learning resources are available online, and you will have workshop training sessions (skype, telephone or face to face) once a month with your trainer. You will have the support of a trainer/assessor throughout your studies.
