## ***CHC53315 Diploma of Mental Health***

The past decade has seen a vast increase in the number of people needed for employment in the community and mental health services. One in three Australians will experience mental health challenges at some point in their lives, and this qualification will equip you with the knowledge and understanding to help those affected by mental health issues.

This Diploma equips you with highly specialised skills that will enable you to provide professional support and guidance to diverse groups and individuals.

This course will equip you with the skills to provide services to clients in relation to mental health issues. You will learn to work with diverse people, collaboration, recovery orientated approaches, advocacy and education/health promotion services. It would enable you to attain high level specialist knowledge, skills and competencies – especially in regard to laws affecting people with mental health issues, the range of services available to them and health issues related to mental health.

### **What you will learn**

You will learn how to offer support to people from varied backgrounds and how to assist those who may have mental health, alcohol and drug issues. There will be advice on skills and techniques which you can implement to promote recovery and well-being. You will further develop your skills on health and safety and decision making. To achieve this qualification, you will need to complete 190 hours of work placement experience.
