If you want to help others in your community improve their lives and enjoy a rewarding career, consider studying the CHC43215 Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs.

The Australian Government is putting more resources into this area and the number of professionals required to work in this field is expected to increase three-fold over the next decade.

Giving back to your community can be very rewarding.

This qualification prepares you for an entry level role in the alcohol and other drugs sector, where you will provide services and interventions to clients with drug and alcohol dependency. The course will teach you how to provide a range of services and interventions for clients with AOD and other complex care issues. Careers include taking up a role as a **Community Support Worker, Detoxification Worker, Alcohol and Drugs Worker** or **Case Worker**.

How you will learn

This CHC43215 Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs is a nationally recognised qualification. Assessments are by way of written assignments. You will receive training and assessor support throughout your studies and no formal entry requirements are needed for this qualification. You are required to complete 120 hours of work placement experience which will be at one of our fully functional rehabilitation centres.



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Flexible and supportive learning:

Learning is over a 10 month period. Your learning resources are available online, and you will have workshop training sessions (skype, telephone or face to face) once a month with your trainer. You will have the support of a trainer/assessor throughout your studies.
