Giving back to your community can be very rewarding.

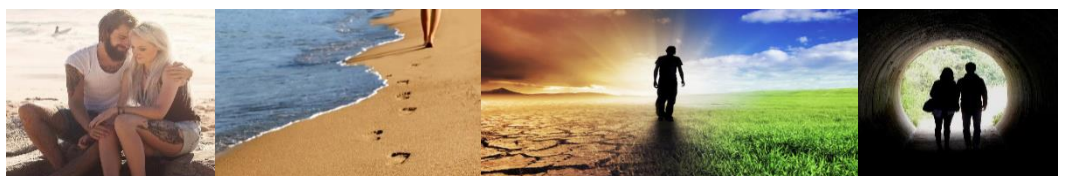
This qualification ensures you have the necessary skills and knowledge to help those who are addicted to alcohol and drugs. The course covers aspects of Alcohol and Other Drugs intervention and strategies, referral, education and health promotion programs, supporting clients through the recovery process, and managing client relationships. Careers include roles as an **Alcohol and Drugs Case Worker**, **Community Support Worker**, **Outreach Worker** or **Community Rehabilitation and Support Worker**.

How you will learn

The CHC53215 Diploma of Alcohol and Other Drugs is a nationally recognised qualification. Assessments are by way of written questioning, case studies and are supplemented by practical activities. You are required to complete 190 hours of work placement experience which will be at one of our fully functional rehabilitation centres.



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Flexible and supportive learning:

The course is delivered over a 12 month period, and we have online delivery with coaching and mentoring, trainer and assessor support.
