## **Dual Program—CHC43215 *Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs* and CHC43315 *Certificate IV in Mental Health***

If you want to help others in your community improve their lives and enjoy a rewarding career, consider studying the CHC43215 Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs along with CHC43315 Certificate IV in Mental Health.

The Australian Government is putting more resources into this area and the number of professionals required to work in this field is expected to increase three-fold over the next decade.

### ***Giving back to your community can be very rewarding.***

These qualifications ensure you have the necessary skills and knowledge to help those who are addicted to alcohol and drugs, and provide services to clients in relation to mental health issues. The course covers aspects of counselling including promoting health and education programs, referral, advocacy, rehabilitation and managing client relationships. Careers include taking up a role as a **Counsellor, Service Coordinator,**

**Youth Liaison Officer** or **Support Worker**. You will learn how to offer support to people from varied backgrounds and how to assist those who may have mental health, alcohol and drug issues. There will be advice on skills and techniques which you can implement to promote recovery and well-being.

#### **Flexible and supportive learning:**

Learning is over a 14-month period. Your learning resources are available online, and you will have workshop training sessions (skype, telephone or face to face) once a month with your trainer.

#### **How you will learn**

This CHC43215 Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs along with CHC43315 Certificate IV in Mental Health is a nationally recognised qualification. You are required to complete 190 hours of work placement experience which will be at one of our fully functional rehabilitation centres.
